Well, here it is, the 2007 Dive list. Hopefully we can cater for everyone's tastes in this year's diving and the viz and weather will be with us.

Please highlight the dives you would like to do and give your list back to me ASAP. Please note the **minimum grade required**.

The rules for dive booking are as follows:

1. Remember that about 30% of all our dives get cancelled due to our fantastic British weather – **DON'T MOAN, IT'S NOBODY'S FAULT**. Book extra at the start of the year to make up for the cancelled dives.
2. Try to book ALL dives for the season in January/February as it'll save being disappointed when trying to get on dives at short notice. Numbers in the club are increasing so spaces will be at a premium.
3. You **must have a current medical/declaration** to participate in dives. This is an insurance as well as safety requirement. **No current medical/declaration, no dive**.
4. Your £30.00 dive deposit and Club Membership **must be fully paid. No money, no dive**. All cheques should be made payable to **CROYDON BSAC 23**.
5. If you do have to pull out of a dive please let me know asap so I can try to find a replacement.
6. If you pull out of a dive with **less than 3 weeks notice** you will be liable for the **full cost** of that dive (i.e. your deposit will be pulled!!). That doesn't stop you finding a replacement but this must meet with The Diving Officer's (**Paul Carvall 07834 049 515**) approval.
7. We need a **£50.00** deposit for any planned weekends away as soon as possible after you get your dive sheets back. The full cost of the weekend including any accommodation must be paid no later than one month before the weekend. All cheques made payable to **CROYDON BSAC 23**.
8. Please come down to the pub on the Wednesday before your booked dive to confirm meeting times etc (or phone me before the Wednesday night).
9. Make sure you phone the dive marshal the night before the dive to check that the dive is on.
10. If you need to hire club equipment it is YOUR responsibility to arrange it in reasonable time with our Equipments Officer (**Alan Lawrence, 07930 149 625**). **THIS INCLUDES MAKING SURE YOUR CYLINDERS ARE FILLED**.

Guide Prices

All the boats charge different amounts depending on distance travelled to the dive site.

A guide price for the 'Open to All' and 'Sports Diver' level dives is **£40 per person per day**.

'Dive Leader' level dives are deeper and therefore probably further offshore, these will (probably) be more expensive, I expect around **£45 per person per day**.
